Spokane County Library District is celebrating **National Library Week, April 9–15, 2017**, with Food for Fines, a community food drive for the Second Harvest Food Bank.

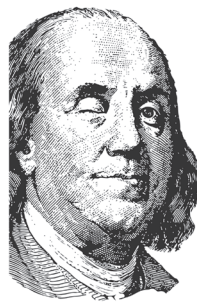
Food for Fines works like this: for each donation of a non-perishable food item, library members can reduce their overdue fines by \$2—for a maximum \$20 forgiven per library account.
