From modest beginnings operating out of borrowed basement space in the early 1940s, Spokane County Library District has been providing access to information and ideas to the citizens of the County. The District has grown to the professional library system it is today operating 10 libraries serving the unincorporated areas of Spokane County and eleven of its cities and towns.

The District continues to be responsive to the evolving needs of the community. In the fall of 2012, the District set in motion a planning process to listen to County residents and learn about their aspirations for our community. From the community conversations and one-on-one interviews emerged a road map for expanding services that have the greatest impact on the community, and to deliver services that are both relevant and responsive for the common good in changing times.

Four areas where libraries are ready to fill needs that lead to addressing challenges and opening doors within our community were identified:

Develop young learners – Provide resources and activities to prepare children, birth to age five, to enter school ready to learn.

Explore and discover – Have resources needed to explore topics of interest, and support to share knowledge with others.

Support job seekers and local businesses – Provide local businesses and non-profits the tools they need to develop and maintain successful enterprises, and provide resources for citizens to attain meaningful employment.

Connect communities – What better place that your neighborhood library to connecting with other community members and engaging in local activities.

The reality is there are no additional resources to fund expanded programs. However, the District has proven good stewardship with funding and will continue to implement efficiency measures to align resources with priorities identified by the community. Watch for programs and partnerships in the coming year that will demonstrate our commitment to these four priorities.
