Spokane Is Reading 2013

Spokane Is Reading welcomes author Maria Semple and her book, *Where'd you go, Bernadette* for the 12th Annual Spokane Is Reading event.

Spokane Is Reading, sponsored and organized by Spokane County Library District, Spokane Public Library, and Auntie's Bookstore, hosts two appearances with Ms. Semple on Thursday, October 10, 2013. The first appearance is at the Convention Center Conference Theater in downtown Spokane at 1pm, and the second at CenterPlace in the Spokane Valley at 7pm. Both events are free admission.

Spokane Is Reading is a community read designed to encourage reading throughout the region and is one of the longest-running community reads in the State of Washington.
