Libraries are on the ballot this summer with proposed changes that more than double the total public library space in the Spokane Valley and Millwood. On August 4, 2015, the Spokane County Library District will ask voters to approve a \$22 million bond to fund four projects:

- A new 30,000 sq. ft. Spokane Valley Library on Sprague Avenue at Herald Road
- A new 10,000 sq. ft. library in Veradale/Greenacres on Conklin Road
- A 6,000 sq. ft. expansion of the Argonne Library
- A repurpose of the existing 60-year-old Spokane Valley Library near Sprague and Pines

If approved, the cost of the bond is approximately 11¢ per \$1000 assessed home value. The owner of a \$200,000 home will pay about \$22 per year for 20 years.
