Exploring Human Origins: What Does It Mean to Be Human?

The North Spokane Library is one of 19 libraries nationwide chosen to host *Exploring Human Origins: What Does It Mean to Be Human?*, a Smithsonian national traveling exhibit exploring the complex field of human evolution research. The exhibit opens on Tuesday, January 5 and runs through Tuesday, February 2. It is accompanied by a series of free programs, including presentations by Smithsonian scientists.

As humans, we possess an innate curiosity to understand where we come from and who we are as individuals. *Exploring Human Origins: What Does It Mean to Be Human?* invites audiences to discover what we know about human evolution and how we know it. Visitors may view replicas and images from the Smithsonian's popular human origins exhibit at the National Museum of Natural History. Experience more than 40 educational panels, interactive kiosks, hands-on displays, videos, 3-D skull casts, and a large reproduction bronze statue.
