

Color Game

Slowly put all the red things up on the board, naming each one as you go.

“This apple is red...this fire engine is red...this ladybug is red...”

Then, put an orange thing up in the same row such as a carrot, but say,

“This carrot is red...”

Your preschoolers will certainly correct you and then you can say,

“How silly, that carrot is orange!”

Toddlers might need a little prompting such as,

“Wait a minute, that carrot isn’t red! What color is it? It’s orange!”

Move the carrot or whatever orange item you used down to the next row.

“So, this carrot is orange...”

Continue, once again ending with the wrong color.

When you get to purple, end with the rainbow.

“This rainbow is purple...wait, it does have purple, but it also has all the other colors!”

**There is a version that uses red, white, and blue objects and then instead of a rainbow you end with the United States Flag.*
