Spokane County Library District's Homeschool library cards are available to families located within the District's service areas: the unincorporated area of Spokane County and annexed or contracting towns.

With this card, homeschooling families may have up to 50 items checked out at one time.

Parents/guardians may obtain a homeschool library card from any District Library by presenting the following.

- Picture ID for the parent/guardian applying for the card.
- Verification of street address (if different from picture ID).
- A copy of the <u>Declaration of Intent to Provide Home-Based Instruction</u> form or a written document stating that the form has been submitted and the school district office where it was filed.

One card will be issued per family living in the same residence. The card is for homeschooling resources only. To check out items, designated family members must have the card in hand or the parent/guardian who applied for the card may present picture ID. Materials borrowed with the homeschool library card do not incur overdue fines; however, the parent/guardian on the card application is responsible for any charges for lost or damaged materials and for all use of the card.

Homeschool cards expire on September 15 of each year. The parent/guardian will be required to present a copy of the current <u>Declaration of Intent to Provide Home-Based Instruction</u> each year to renew the card.
