You can start a Udemy course at any time and take as long as you need to finish it. If the content in a video is particularly challenging, you can pause and rewind as much as needed. You can also unenroll and try a different class at any time. All classes include study guides along with videos and vary in length. For example, Udemy's sewing class has only 1.5 hours of videos, while the American Sign Language class includes 49 hours of content.
