During **Drop-in Business Mentoring**, people can get answers to their questions about starting or expanding their business from SCORE business mentor Ron Barkley. Entrepreneurs and business owners can also get free assistance with a range of topics, including:

- Writing a business plan
- Completing financial projections
- Analyzing financial statements
- Preparing loan requests before meeting with lenders

Mentoring help is available on a first-come, first-served basis on the third Tuesday of each month, 1:30–4pm, at Deer Park Library (208 S Forest Ave).

Upcoming sessions for Drop-in Business Mentoring are April 16, May 21, and June 17.
