

Unit Name/Theme: Number Game/Construction

What are we doing? We will be working on number recognition and sequencing.

Purpose/Why? Children will learn to count to 20 by rote and be able to count 10 or more objects accurately. Children will learn to give a number that comes next in a sequence.

Materials Provided: Number Cards

Books:

"Whose Tools?" by Toni Buzzeo and Jim Datz



Quick Start

Start with numbers 1-5. Help your child identify and put numbers in order on a table or the floor. Mix up the numbers and have the child put them in order by themselves, giving hints when needed. (You have a 1, what's next? Where is the "2"?)



Deeper Dive

Continue to add more numbers as your child masters the game.



Ask a Question

- How high can you count?
- Where is the number "5"?
- Is that number bigger or smaller than this one?
- What comes next?

Other Activities:

Go on a number hunt. What numbers can you find numbers in the house? What numbers can you find riding in the car or bus? What numbers can you find at the store?
